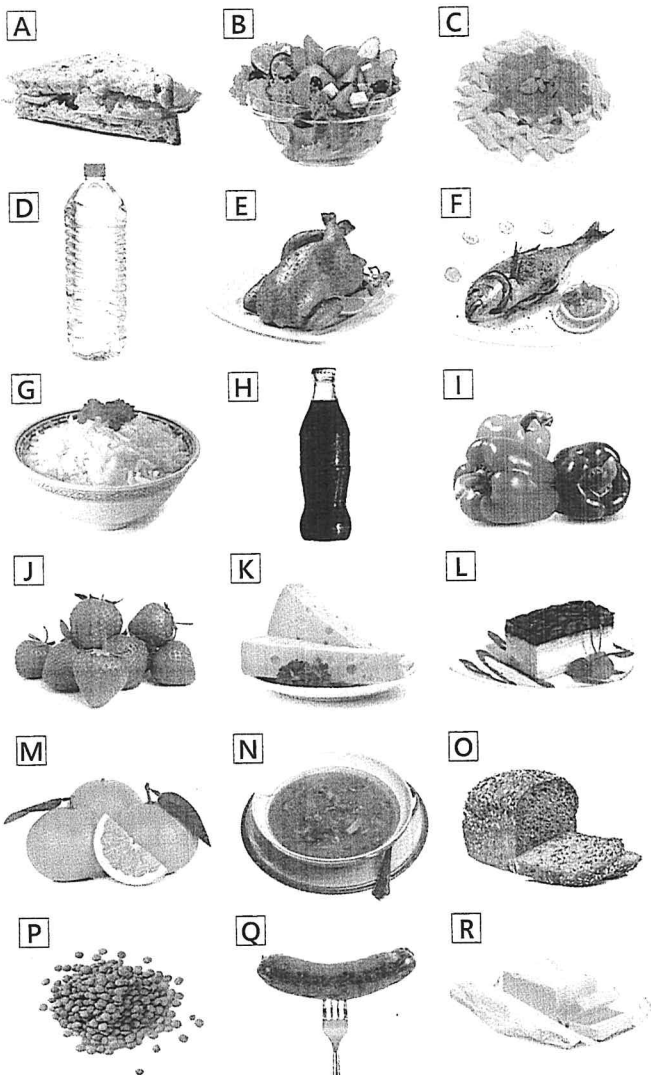

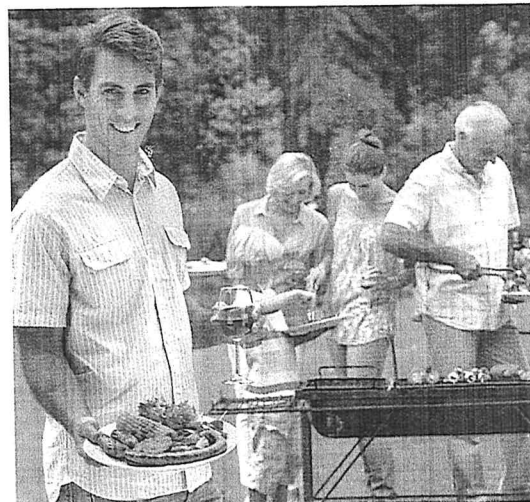

Eating 'al fresco

The sun doesn't always shine in summer in Britain, so British people can't often eat 'al fresco', or outside, but when the weather is good, they love having a picnic, or a barbecue!

Barbecues are usually in people's garden and they sometimes make a special place in the garden to cook the barbecue. These are called barbecue pits or 'barbies'. At the beach and in local parks in the UK, there are often public barbies for people to come and cook their food on. These are free for everyone to use.

But what are British people's favourite barbecue foods? Hamburgers seem to be number one barbecue meat in the UK, followed by sausages and chicken. For those who don't eat any meat, the alternative is the evergreen corn on the cob, or any other vegetable like tomatoes, aubergines, courgettes or jacked potatoes. You can also grill some fruit on the barbecue, such as bananas and apples with sugar and cinnamon on top.
